



Where do these common oral care ingredients rank on the EWG scale*:

The **higher** the number, the more **hazardous** the ingredient.

Benzyl Alcohol	4-6	allergies & immunotoxicity
Fd&C Blue No. 1	3-8	cancer concerns
Titanium Dioxide	3	cancer concerns
Peppermint Oil	5	allergies & immunotoxicity
Cocamidopropyl Betaine	1-5	allergies & immunotoxicity
Ylang Ylang	3-5	toxicant & allergen
Methylparaben	3-4	allergen & endocrine disruptor
Propylparaben	9	endocrine disruptor
Citrus Aurantium Dulcis	5-7	skin toxicant & allergen
PEG-8 to 14	1-3	sense organ toxicity
Sodium Lauryl Sulfate	1-2	irritant
Propylene Glycol	3	allergies
Diethanolamine	10	respiratory toxicant & cancer
PTFE (Teflon)	10	developmental & reproductive toxicity
